## Fatality at CITIC Pacific Mining's Sino Iron project site

CITIC Pacific Mining and Downer EDI Mining regret to advise that a fatality involving a 34 year-old male Downer EDI Mining employee occurred in the mine area at the Sino Iron project site at around 3:15am today. The site is located at Cape Preston, around 100kms south west of Karratha.

The name of the person has not been released at this stage. All work on site has stopped, including all project construction. Emergency services are at the location. Both companies are focussing all efforts to provide support to family, friends and colleagues and are also assisting emergency services. Counselling support services are being made available.
